- <u>1.</u> <u>Sonata and Sonatina Festival</u> for all current NMA piano students.
- Saturday, November 1, 2025
- Fee: \$35 payable by check or cash to your teacher or NMA; for credit card payments add a \$5 processing charge
- Location: North Central College in downtown Naperville
- Fee payment and registration: Sept 4 Oct 4, 2025.
- Awards: Certificate and trophies for top ranking students

- Students submit to NMA the <u>videos performing any song and in any style</u>. No required repertoire lists, but piano and strings students can use the songs from the IMA competition required lists. Students can also use the songs from the IMS competition required list.

- 1. AIM Piano Theory Exams (IL State Piano Exams) Levels 3-12 for all current NMA piano students
- Saturday, December 6 and Saturday, December 13, 2025 (tentative).
- Fee: \$25 payable by check or cash to NMA or your teacher; for credit card payments add a \$5 processing charge
- Location: Wentz Hall and Community United Methodist Church in downtown Naperville
- Registration and fee payment: Sept 25 October 25, 2025.
- Awards: ISMTA Certificate after successfully passing the performance exam in March 2026.
- 2. AIM Piano Exams (IL State Piano Exams) Theory and Performance, Levels 1-2 for all current NMA piano students

- Fee: \$30 payable by check or cash to NMA or your teacher; for credit card payments add a \$5 processing charge

- 3. <u>AIM Piano Performance Exam (IL State Piano Exam) Levels 3-12</u> for all current NMA piano students who successfully passed the theory AIM exam in December.
- Saturday, March 14, Sunday, March 15, Saturday, March 21, Sunday March 6, 2026 (tentative).
- Fee: \$25 payable by check to NMA or your teacher; for credit card payments add a \$5 processing charge
- Registration and fee payment: Dec 6, 2025 Jan 6, 2026.
- Location: Wentz Hall and Community United Methodist Church, both in downtown Naperville.
- Awards: ISMTA Certificate for passing both theory and performance portions; plaques for students who completed at least 9 levels out of 12.

ALL STUDENTS

- <u>1.</u> <u>Trinity College London Exams</u> for all current NMA students. NOTE: NMA is the only licensed Trinity College London testing center in the Midwest and can enter only current NMA students.
- Fee depends on the level, between \$125 and \$280 per exam. No additional fees for credit card payments.
- Registration and fee payment deadlines and video submission deadlines:

September 13, 2025 - video submission by October 4, 2025 December 17, 2025 - video submission by January 15, 2026.

- For May deadline see below.
- Please note that once your teacher decides about the level, we will send an invoice for the registration fee.
- Location: exams recorded digitally, and videos in mp4 or .mov format, smaller than 1 gb, emailed to NMA.
- Awards: TCL certificate recognized and highly respected in numerous countries and educational institutions around the world.

- Fee: \$44 payable by credit card, check, or cash. No additional charges for credit card payments.

- Awards: Certificates and medals
- 3. National Music Theory Honor Roll Exam for all current NMA students
- Sunday, April 19, 2026 (Also, see below the July exam date.)
- Fee: \$43 per exam payable by credit card, check, or cash. No additional charges for credit card payments.

- Fee depends on the level, between \$125 and \$280 per exam.
- Registration and fee payment: May 23, 2026; video submission by June 13, 2026.
- Please note that once your teacher decides about the level, we will send an invoice for the registration fee.
- Location: exams recorded digitally, and videos in mp4 or .mov format, smaller than 1 gb, emailed to NMA.
- Awards: TCL certificate recognized and highly respected in numerous countries and educational institutions around the world.
- 5. National Music Theory Honor Roll Exam for all currently enrolled NMA students
- Sunday, July 25, 2026.
- Fee: \$43 per exam per student payable by credit card, check, or cash. No additional charges for credit card payments.
- Location: NMA
- Registration and fee payment: June 12 July 12, 2026.
- Awards: Certificates, medals and listing on National Music Theory Honor Roll List for students with scores 90% and higher

STRINGS ONLY

- 1. AIM Exam for Strings (IL State Strings Exams) Levels 1-10 for all current NMA strings students
- Sunday, May 3, 2026
- Location: NMA
- Fee: \$30 for levels 1-2; \$50 for levels 3-10 (\$25 for theory and \$25 for performance exam) payable by check or cash to NMA or your teacher; for credit card payments please add a \$5 processing charge
- Registration and fee payment: Feb 21 Mar 21, 2026.
- Awards: ISMTA Certificate for passing both theory and performance portions; plaques for students who complete all 10 levels.

SINGING ONLY

- 1. AIM Voice Exam (IL State Voice Exam) for all current NMA voice students
- Sunday, May 3, 2026.
- Location: NMA
- Fee: \$30 for level 1; \$50 for levels 2-8 (\$25 for theory and \$25 for performance) payable by check or cash to NMA or your teacher; for credit card payments add a \$5 processing charge
- Registration and fee payment: Feb 21 Mar 21, 2026.
- Awards: ISMTA Certificates for students who successfully pass both theory and performance exams; plaques for students who completed level 8.

ALL STUDENTS

- <u>1.</u> <u>Illinois Music Society Annual Competition</u> for all current NMA students. Young students and beginners are strongly encouraged to join.
- Saturday, October 18, 2025: guitar, drums, piano, voice, violin, viola.
- Fee: \$42 per event. Students registering for multiple events must submit a \$42 fee for each event.
- Fee submitted in cash, check or credit card to NMA. No additional charges for credit card payments.
- Registration and fee payment deadline: Aug 25 Sept 20, 2025.
- Location: Community United Methodist Church in downtown Naperville
- Awards: trophies for the competitors winning 1st, 2nd and 3rd place, ribbons for others, certificates for all, and a \$25 monetary award for 1st place winners.
- 2. <u>Illinois Music Association Contest</u> for all current NMA students
- Saturday and Sunday, May 30 and 31, 2026. Saturday piano, voice (all categories), and possibly guitar and drums; Sunday piano and strings.
- Fee: \$42 per student per event, payable in cash or check to NMA; for credit card payments add a \$5 processing charge.
 Piano students choosing a specific day add \$1 scheduling fee.
